

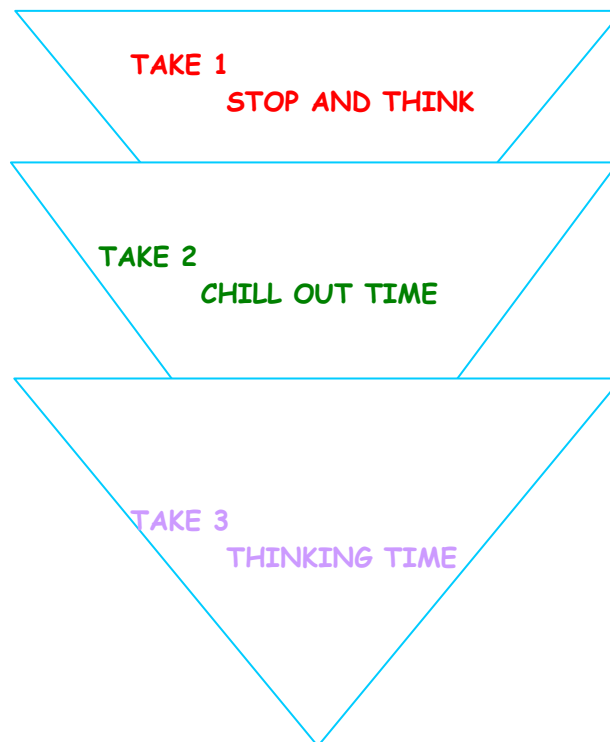
THE NON-BLAME SOCIAL CONSEQUENCE SYSTEM

The non-blame social consequence system involves your child thinking about the behaviours s/he is choosing, reflecting on the effectiveness and appropriateness of said behaviours, owning her/his behaviour choices and thinking about behaviours that may be more appropriate if the situation were to happen again.

Each 'take' time is for a longer time period - initially perhaps one minute, then 3/5 minutes then 5/10 minutes. You need to work with your child to teach her/him the purpose of thinking time - to assist them focus their attention and energies on questions such as: 'What was I doing?', 'What do I need to be doing differently?', 'How will I do this?'. These questions help your child become reflective social problem solvers as well as assist her/him develop a sense of self responsibility and ownership of behaviour choices.

REMEMBER TO TEACH AND LINK THIS SYSTEM WITH THE BEHAVIOUR TEACHING PROCESS. TEACH IT AS YOU WOULD TEACH A NEW BEHAVIOUR.
